**It's Easy to Sign-up and Report your Results**

1. A WSH Membership is required to sign-up for Working Horse Division Year-End Awards.
2. Complete and submit the Working Horse Division Recording Form.
3. Once your Recording Form is received, you will begin earning points for your Year-End Awards.
4. After you compete at an event, ask the show secretary to sign your Exhibitor Reporting Form to verify the class name, number of exhibitors in the class, and your placing in the class.
5. Within 30 days of your event, submit your signed and completed Exhibitor Recording Form to the Working Horse Division Committee with the event class schedule.

**\*\*For 2015-2016, a 60-day retro-active period is enacted as this is a new division to WSH.**

**Recognizing Your Success**

**High Point Awards will be awarded to the highest scoring  
Youth, 17 & Under, and Adult, 18 & Over, in each event.**

**A Working Horse Division Overall High Point Champion  
will be awarded to the horse/rider who has earned the most total points in one or more events.**

**Outstanding achievement in the  
Working Horse Division will be recognized in each event.**

Certificate of Recognition—10 Points

Certificate of Achievement—25 points

Certificate of Excellence—50 points

Certificate of Outstanding Achievement—75 Points

Certificate of Superior Excellence—100 Points

Certificate of Supreme Excellence—200 Points and above
