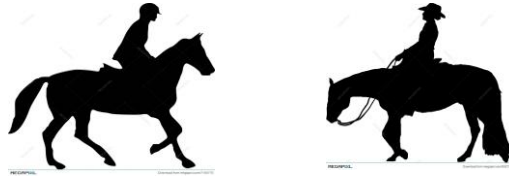

RULES OF COMPETITION FOR SSSC OPEN SHOWS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS GOVERNED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT WSH/USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREIN

- Returned check fee: \$25
- **AMATEUR**—Riders/Handlers over age 18--WSH shows accept:
 - ApHC, AQHA, AMHA, APHA, PtHA, NRHA, WSH, USEF Amateur, Non-Pro Card, Youth Novice or Youth Card.
 - To enter Amateur classes (showmanship and equitation), current amateur card is required or application may be made with the show secretary at least one hour prior to first class.
 - WSH issues Amateur card for \$12. Fee is waived for WSH members participating in 2 WSH Annual High Score Awards.
 - **PHOTOCOPY MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH ENTRY FOR AMATEUR STATUS.**
- **WSH NON-MEMBER**- fee of \$3 per judge per day is charged for exhibitors who are not members of WSH. Joining WSH at the show will remove this fee for the show and subsequent WSH shows during the 2018 show year.
- **NUMBERS**-
 - Exhibitors numbers must be adequately attached to Exhibitor's back or on each side of the saddle pad; with exception that "in-hand" classes the number can be pinned to the front of the exhibitor.
 - **NUMBERS MUST BE VISIBLY NOTICABLE FROM ACROSS THE ARENA.**
 - **COMPETITORS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF THE CORRECT NUMBER IS NOT IN PLACE.**
 - WSH issues Permanent numbers (500 and above) when Exhibitor has signed up for WSH Year End Award program—**ONLY** those exhibitors who have signed up for the **CURRENT** year for WSH yearend awards may use a permanent number.
 - Show Steward can assist you with sign up for WSH Yearend awards-new or renewal.
- **GATE HOLDS**- are allowed when approved by the show steward. Limited to 3 minutes.
- **CHANGES**- Show management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes or split classes as needed to comply with WSH rules or exhibitor safety.
- **CONDUCT**-Show management reserves the right to refuse entry or participation of any exhibitor, trainer, rider, agent or driver who has shown objectionable behavior or unsportsmanlike conduct towards show, exhibitors or staff.
- **ENTRIES/ PAYMENTS**-
 - Must be in writing signed by owner/authorized agent and rider/handler and accompanied by proper fees.
 - Parent/guardian must sign entry and hold harmless agreement of a junior rider.
 - Registry numbers and full registered name is required for entry in classes for registered horses. Papers must be presented unless a photo copy is included with entry.
 - **WSH MEMBERSHIP CARD, AMATEUR CARD PHOTO COPIES MUST BE ATTACHED TO ENTRY.** Show steward/show secretary can assist you with new or renewing membership or Amateur card.
 - **PRE ENTRY** must include payment for 3 classes and stall (if requested).
 - **POST ENTRY** will be accepted with a \$20 per DAY late fee.
 - **OPEN** checks will be accepted at the show.
 - Scratched classes are charged to show tab **UNLESS** the exhibitor/horse is ineligible for the entered class.
 - **BLANKET FEE** is \$190 **PRE ENTRY PER DAY**--\$210 **POST ENTRY-PER DAY.**
 - **REFUND** of fees will be made **ONLY** with VET Certificate specifying exact disability. \$20 office fee and stall fee will be not be refunded. Refund checks will be mailed.
 - **STALLS ARE LIMITED—ONLY PRE-ENTRIES CAN BE GUARANTEED A STALL.**
- **STALLIONS**-Exhibitors under age 18 may not ride stallions. JR exhibitors 16 and older may show yearling and under stallions in open in-hand classes.
- **HELMETS**-ALL riders of ANY age in Hunter Seat attire must wear a properly fastened approved ASTM/SEI helmet while mounted. **EXHIBITORS OF ANY AGE MAY WEAR HELMETS IN ANY CLASS WITHOUT PENALTY.**
- **CROSS ENTRY RULES:**
 - Walk/Trot/Jog 10 & under riders **MAY NOT** cross enter to 3 gaited classes at same show.
 - W/T -J Amateur/Open Riders **MAY NOT** cross enter to 3 gaited classes with the same horse/rider combination; **BUT** may ride in a different horse/rider combination in 3 gaited classes.
 - Riders in Limit or Green W/T-J **MAY** cross enter to 3 gaited classes.
 - Horses ridden in Walk/T-J 10 & Under Riders or W/T-J Amateur or Open Riders **MAY** be ridden in 3 gaited classes by **ANOTHER RIDER.**

- **GREEN AND LIMIT HORSE/RIDER RULES:**
 - Green Horse/Rider must be in 1st/2nd year of showing in that seat or discipline. Previous wins in Walk Trot Rider 10 & under classes do not affect Green Rider status.
 - Limit Horse/Rider may not have won 6 firsts in seat/discipline—previous wins in 4-H, WASHET, schooling shows and Walk Trot 10 & under do not affect Limit Rider status.
 - Limit and Green status apply for entire 2018 show year.
- **ZONE AND WSH YEAR END AWARDS POINTS--**Must be signed up for Zone and/or WSH yearend awards at or before show for points to count.
- **PROTESTS--**Only written protests, signed and addressed to Show Secretary and received by the Steward, Show Manager, Show Secretary within 48 hours of the occurrence of the violation and accompanied by a \$50 check deposit (made to WSH-HSD) or sent directly to the WSH Horse Show Division Director and received within 5 business days following the last day to the show will be reviewed. IF the objection is NOT sustained the deposit is forfeited. IF the objection is upheld the check or \$50 fee will be returned.
- **JUDGES--** No one shall approach a Judge in regard to a decision unless he/she first obtains permission from the Show Steward. The decision of the Judge is final. Exhibitors may request thru the Show Steward that a Judge provide advice or other comments at the END of the competition.
- **PATTERNS—**will be posted and/or available to exhibitors at least one hour prior to the conduct of the class where the pattern will be used. IF there is a difference between the written description and the drawn pattern, the WRITTEN description shall be used UNLESS the judge/s makes corrections prior to the first exhibitor beginning the pattern and all exhibitors are notified of change.
- **LOSS AND INJURY—**SSSC, PRZ, STICK HORSE RANCH, WSH, its members, members of the Show Committee, and their Associates will not be responsible for any loss or damage to horses exhibited, or for any article or any kind that may be lost or destroyed or in any way injured. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to person, whomsoever, by any horses owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify SSSC, PRZ, STICK HORSE RANCH, WSH, its members, members of the Show Committee and their Associates against all claims and demands of any kind or nature that may grow out of injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her or arise from the negligence of person in charge of such horse. The owner, rider, and any of their agents or representatives acknowledge they participate voluntarily in the completion fully aware that horse sport and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss, and they agree to hold the competition and its officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents. Submitting entry shall constitute acceptance by the owner and exhibitor of all provisions as set forth within. The SSSC, PRZ, STICK HORSE RANCH, WSH, its members, members of the Show Committee and their Associates cannot be held liable for loss or injury to the person or property of any visitor, guest or spectator.
- **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS-**for WSH classes can be found in the current Washington State Horsemen Rule Book (available online at www.washingtonstatehorsemen.org) and the USEF Rule book (available online at www.usef.org). The Show Steward has access to rule books. You may direct questions to the Show Steward.
- **DOGS—MUST BE LEASHED AND NOT LEFT UNATTENDED IN TRAILERS OR VEHICLES. NOT ALLOWED IN ARENA.**
- **NO TOBACCO, MARIJUANA, VAPING, ALCOHOL OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES PERMITTED ON PREMISES.**

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition--Hop Into Spring Open Quad Show--to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (“Harm”).

I AGREE to release Washington State Horsemen (WSH), South Sound Saddle Club (SSSC), Prairie Zone (PRZ), Stick Horse Ranch and any other sponsors from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of Washington State Horsemen or the Competition or other sponsors or Stick Horse Ranch.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of Washington State Horsemen or SSSC or PRZ or other sponsors or Stick Horse Ranch.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) Washington State Horsemen and SSSC, PRZ and Stick Horse Ranch and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

I have read the Washington State Horsemen Rules about protective equipment, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that Washington State Horsemen strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that protective equipment cannot guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child’s participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child’s behalf.

I AGREE that Washington State Horsemen, SSSC, PRZ, Stick Horse Ranch and “Competition” as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, and affiliated organizations. The construction or application of WSH rules is governed by the laws of the State of Washington (RCW 4.4).
