The Working Horse Division is open to all horses and riders in events that offer competition to exhibitors in any of the Working Horse Division events in Washington State.

Events to count for year end awards:

It's Easy to Sign-up and Report your Results

1. Become a member of Washington State Horsemen by going to their website at: <http://washingtonstatehorsemen.org/> scroll down to the bottom of the Home Page and click on 'Become a Member'. Click on and download the **Non – Club Membership Application PDF**. **Fill it out and send it in with your membership payment.**
2. A Membership Card and Number will be mailed to you from Washington State Horsemen.
3. Download the Working Horse Year-End Award Sign Up Sheet from the Washington State Horsemen website and mail it along with the appropriate fee to the WSH Working Horse Director, Attn: Susan Adrian, PO Box 657, Deming, WA 98244.
4. Download the Working Horse Recording Form from the Washington State Horsemen website and begin earning points by attending shows within the Working Horse events. Shows will be posted on the WSH website and facebook page.
5. After you complete an event, ask the show secretary to sign your Recording Form to verify the class name, number of exhibitors in the class and your placing in the class.
6. Within 30 days of your event, submit your signed and completed Recording Form to the WSH Working Horse Director, Attn: Susan Adrian, PO Box 657, Deming, WA 98244 or

you may email your results to hidnriver@comcast.net. Please also provide a copy of the event schedule.

*NOTE: Since this is a fairly new division, a retro-active period will be enacted as the starting date to record events. Begin recording events from October 1st of the previous year to Sept 30th of the current year. You may record past events as long as you have the show secretaries sign your Recording Form along with their phone numbers. If you have a past class schedule of the show, please include a copy of that also. Please only One Recording Form per event/show.

Recognizing Your Success

Overall High Point Awards will be given to the highest scoring exhibitors in all events combined as follows:

Junior (17 & Under)

Adult (18 & Over)

Green Rider (1st & 2nd Year Showing)

Green Horse (1st & 2nd Year Showing)

A Perpetual Working Horse Division Trophy will be awarded to the highest scoring horse/rider who has earned the most total points in one or more events.

Yearly outstanding achievement award certificates will be recognized in **each** event as follows:

Certificate of Recognition – 10 Points

Certificate of Achievement – 25 Points

Certificate of Excellence – 50 Points

Certificate of Outstanding Achievement – 75 Points

Certificate of Superior Excellence – 100 Points

Certificate of Supreme Excellence – 200 Points and above

** All awards are based on one horse/rider combinations.

Point tabulations for all Working Horse Division categories are as follows:

A. 1st Place = 6 Points

B. 2nd Place = 5 Points

C. 3rd Place = 4 Points

D. 4th Place = 3 points

E. 5th Place = 2 Points

F. 6th Place = 1 Point

Year-end Awards will be presented at the annual Washington State Horsemen Convention. The Convention date and place is advertised on the WSH website. If you cannot attend the Convention to pick up your award, please email the WSH Working Horse Director by October 15th and let him/her know who will be picking up your award for you.
