## It is Easy to Sign-up & Report your Results

1. WSH Membership is required to sign-up for Working Horse Division Year-End Awards.
2. Complete and submit the Working Horse Division Year-End Awards Sign-up Form.
3. After your sign-up form is received and you are issued a WSH membership number, you can begin earning points for your Year-End Awards. Download from our website the Working Horse Division Reporting Form.
4. Once you complete an event have the show's secretary sign your Reporting Form to verify the class name, number of exhibitors and your placings.
5. Within 30 days of the event, submit your signed Recording Form to the Working Horse Division Director (listed on the form). Please also include the show schedule if available. Multiple forms can be submitted.



## Recognition of your Success

High Point Awards will be awarded to the highest scoring Junior (17 & Under), Adult (18 & Over), Green Rider (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Showing), and Green Horse (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Showing). A Perpetual Working Horse Division Trophy will be awarded to the highest scoring horse/rider combination who has earned the most total points in one or more events.

Yearly outstanding achievement award certificates will be recognized in each event as follows:

Certificate of Recognition – 10 Points  
Certificate of Achievement – 25 Points  
Certificate of Excellence – 50 Points  
Outstanding Achievement – 75 Pts  
Superior Excellence – 100 Points  
Supreme Excellence – 200 Points  
\*All awards are based on one horse/rider combination.

Year-end Awards will be presented at the Annual Washington State Horsemen Convention. The Convention date and place is advertised on the WSH website. If you cannot attend the Convention to pick up your award, please email the WSH Working Horse Director by October 15<sup>th</sup> to make other arrangements.
