RULES & INFORMATION

GENERAL RULES - APPLIES TO THE ENTIRE WEEKEND

We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone for any reason. When available, patterns will be posted at www.horseshow entry.com. Stall charts will be posted the night before the show. Bad weather IE; snow or ice may cancel a show. Watch facebook for all updates.

GATE CALLS: gate calls are a courtesy. While we will do everything we can to make you aware what class is entering the arena, you are responsible to be at the gate when your class is entering the arena. Once the gate is closed no horses can be added to the class.

NO BABY CARRIAGES, CHILDREN, SPECTATORS OR DOGS IN THE WARM UP AREN A/HOLDING PEN. Dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are not permitted in the stands, holding area for horses or inside the arena. NO EXCEPTIONS. Spectators, children not showing and baby carriages need to go to the stands.

There is no access to the stands thru the holding pen on the northwest side of the arena. You will need to walk around.

JUDGES AND/OR MANAGEMENTS DECISIONS ARE FINAL

Unruly or dangerous horses will be asked to leave.

Every horse/exhibitor entering the class must be wearing an assigned show number. If you are not wearing your number or you are wearing the wrong number you will be disqualified.

If your back number is on both the announcer's sheet and the gate persons sheet, you will be charged for the Class

Horses hauled in and shown from their trailer will be charged a \$10 haul in fee and are responsible for cleaning up after themselves. Bring a shovel or pitch fork to clean up your mess if you show out of your trailer. LEAVE NO MESS BEHIND

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS ELIGIBILITY: You must show in qualifying classes to be eligible for championship classes. You DO NOT have to place 1st and/or 2nd. You just need to SHOW in a qualifying class.

HIGH POINTS: To be Eligible to win High Points: One Horse/ Rider Combo. Categories MUST be declared by Exhibitor on their entry form. You MUST ride in at least 4 qualifying classes to win. Winners must be in attendance to receive their prize or make arrangements for someone to pick up. Prizes will not be mailed or held over.

TABULATION: Tabulation for high Points: Must have at least 2 riding in the class for points to count 1st – 7pts, 2nd – 6pts, 3rd – 5pts, 4th – 4pts, 5th – 3pts, 6th – 2pts, 1 point will be awarded to each entrant that shows in a class but does not place. Points are given regardless of the number of horses in the class.

REFUNDS: Refunds will only be given for pre-entries for sick or injured horses with a vets certificate less a \$25 admin fee. Refunds will be mailed after the show and once required documentation is received.

PAYMENT: A form of payment must accompany all entries before said horse/rider go into the class. Payment of 2 classes on a pre-entry required to be considered a pre-entry. Classes may be added at the show. We will accept cash, checks and credit cards. A \$45 fee will be added to any NSF checks. No refunds will be given

for scratched classes to entries that pay upfront with cash. We HIGHLY RECOMMEND leaving an open check or credit card on file when you enter the show. You can pay any way you want when you check out. A 3% FEE WILL BE ADDED TO ANY SHOWBILL TOTAL THAT IS PAID WITH A CREDIT CARD.

STATEMENTS: Your statement will include all charges, payment, placings and number of horses in each class. A results book will be posted in the foyer with results of each class as we process them in the show office. Additionally, a copy of the score sheets will be posted onsite as well.

SCRATCHED CLASSES: IF ADD/SCRATCH Sheet is filed prior to the class, you have an open check or credit card on file and you take the yellow copy to the gate person, you will not be charged for the SCRATCHED class. Failure to fill out an add/scratch slip for scratched classes will result in you being charged. Yes this is a process we need for our records. No excuses accepted.

Reserved stalls must be pre-paid. If you are a trainer or a group that want to be stalled together, a list must be submitted to the stall manager.

Dogs MUST be kept on a leash either held on to by a human, tied or contained and NOT left unattended in trailers, vehicles, stall or barn. Dogs are not allowed in the bleachers/stands. Barking dogs will not be tolerated for any reason.

All horses and all riders MUST be entered in the show to ride/ridden on the show grounds. Liability release MUST be signed before riding or lunging on the show grounds.

Signed check payable to Tacoma Unit, PLUS copy of WSH membership number if a WSH member, breed registration and Amateur card MUST accompany entry form to be a valid pre-entry.

YOUTH & AMATEUR CARDS: WSH Horse Shows accept ApHC, ABRA, AQHA, AMHA, APHA, PtHA, NRHA, WSH, USEF Amateur Cards/Non-Pro Card and Youth Novice or Youth cards for exhibitors who are 18 and under. A Sr. exhibitor (18 & Over) showing in equitation classes must have an amateur card from one of the following ApHC, ABRA, AQHA, AMHA, APHA, PtHA, NRHA, WSH, USEF Amateur Cards/Non-Pro Card, Youth Novice or Youth card or pay the WSH amateur fee \$12. See Rule 3 Section 2 for definitions of amateur.

Amateur / non-pro cards are accepted from other associations if you are riding in amateur. If you do not have an amateur card with another association, an amateur card can be purchased at the show for \$15

AGE OF EXHIBITOR: For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor on Dec. 1 shall be maintained the entire year. Persons born on Dec. 1 assume the greater age on that date. A junior has not reached his/her 18th birthday on Dec. 1. A senior is 18 years or over on Dec. I.

ENTRIES: Entries can be mailed to the show secretary along with all applicable paperwork. Checks are made out to TACOMA UNIT. Mailing Address: Karen Lunan, PO Box 1164, McKenna WA 98558. Online entries & Stall reservations: Go to www.horseshowentry.com. Emailed entries can be accepted at showyourhorse@aol.com in the form of a pdf attached to the email. No faxes, no jpg cell phone pics, no text messages and no over the phone entries will be taken.

Pre entries MUST be post marked by March 18th, 2020.

Post entries accepted until 7:45 AM for the first 3 classes of the day. Refunds are not given for un-ridden /missed classes if an ADD/SCRATCH slip has not been filled out.

A fee of \$45.00 will be charged for all returned and NSF checks plus all other fees that are charged by the bank. All points for all approvals will be held until check is reconciled.

A \$10.00 Office fee will be assessed for EACH Horse/Rider combination.

A \$15 fee will be assessed for each **post entry** Horse/Rider combination

A prize will be awarded in all classes to 6th place under call judge. Champion and Reserve rosettes.

To be Eligible to win High Points: Categories MUST be checked by Exhibitor on their entry form. You MUST show in at least 4 qualifying classes to win. Tacoma Unit Ranch Horse Spectacular is operated in accordance with the current rules of WASHINGTON STATE HORSEMEN Horse Show Division of which body it is a "B" System Show

Participating horses may arrive at noon (or later) on Friday, March 27th, 2020. Stalls will be unlocked for those that reserved a stall. A show committee person will be onsite for those arriving with no reservation to unlock stalls.
