**PROPOSED RULE CHANGE...** Acting Director, Lisa Gardner, stated that the Horse Show Division Committee met after Convention and will be asking the WSH Board at their January 7 meeting to pass the following rule change. The rule change (if passed) would take effect immediately however will also be brought back before the Horse Show Division membership at the 2023 Convention.

### Rule 9, Section 2, Paragraph 2

Currently reads, "If the sick official is the Steward, the Judges will continue without the steward and will make all decisions of the Steward".

Proposed change to read, "If the sick official is the Steward, and a replacement Steward cannot be secured, a WSH judge (not already contracted to judge that show) can fill the Steward position for the show. Show management should reach out to the WSH LOC Chair for assistance, if necessary. If a WSH Steward or Judge cannot be arranged for, the Judges will continue without the Steward and will make all decisions of the Steward."
